Gaming Industry Thought Leaders Gather in Miami for Annual Conference

Jones Walker Partner, Marc W. Dunbar, to Moderate Panel on Gaming Regulation and Taxation

MIAMI, Fla. - Jones Walker partner Marc W. Dunbar joined gaming industry thought leaders at the GiGse conference in Miami this week.

On Thursday, Mr. Dunbar moderated a panel discussion on “Regulating and Taxing Sports Betting: Reviewing the options and how they will define the future of the market.”

A professor of gaming law at FSU’s College of Law, and considered one of the country’s foremost thought leaders on gaming regulation, Mr. Dunbar moderated the panel which included gaming regulators, a former Arena Football League commissioner and lawmakers.

During the panel, the discussion focused on the current regulatory climate and its impact on gaming companies and operations around the country as well as taxation and a comparison of U.S. gaming regulation to the current landscape of gaming operations in Europe.

GiGse is an annual conference dedicated to evaluating current trend in the U.S. gaming industry. The two-day event gives operators, regulators and suppliers a platform to network, learn and drive the gaming industry forward. The event includes keynotes, panel sessions and workshops for its attendees.

In addition to having one of the largest gaming practices in the southeast, Mr. Dunbar teaches Gambling and Pari-mutuel Law at Florida State University College of Law, and hosts www.floridagamingwatch.com, a website dedicated to covering trends in the gaming industry.
